Please make sure that you select the correct port from your projector, TV or your display INPUT so that your computer display can be shown.

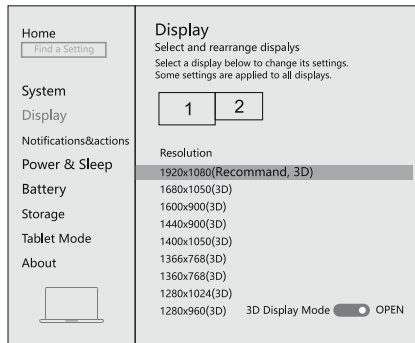

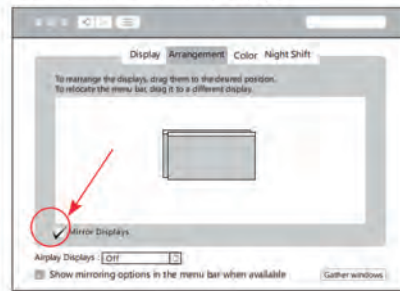

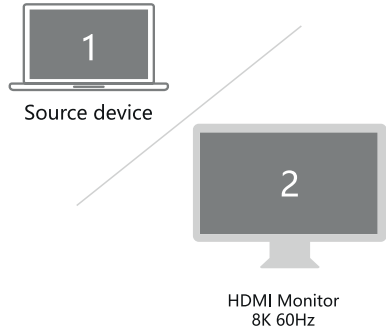

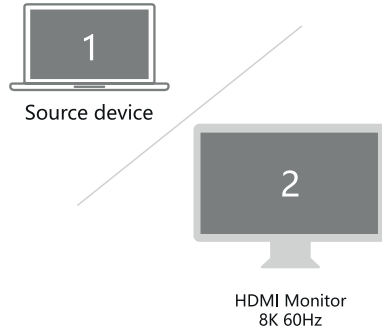
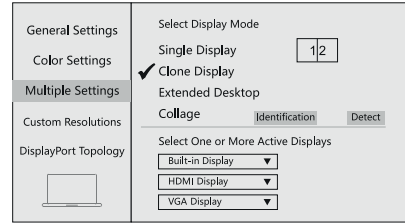

1. Clone Mode

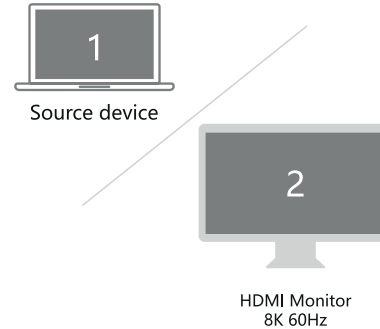
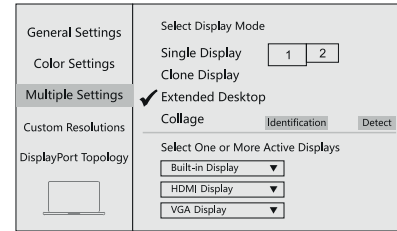
